Alpine Waste & Recycling, Spearheading Natural Gas Efforts in Denver Area, Takes Delivery of 10th CNG Vehicle

COMMERCE CITY, Colo. (Sept. 19, 2011) — Alpine Waste & Recycling, the first waste-hauling company in the six-county Denver metro area with its own on-site, natural gas fueling station, has taken delivery of its 10th compressed natural gas-powered vehicle. Alpine Waste plans to finish converting its entire fleet of vehicles to natural gas within three years.

[Alpine](#) has been at the forefront of Colorado companies when it comes to investing in efficient, environmentally friendly technologies. The company is the largest privately held venture in Colorado to have an onsite natural gas fueling station. Alpine President John Griffith has said his company is committed to helping the state's economy through the use of this Colorado-produced resource.

Alpine took delivery of its first natural gas truck in 2009. Its new fueling station on East 84th Avenue in Commerce City, with 26 natural gas pumps, opened in April of this year.

The company partnered with Seal Beach, Calif.-based [Clean Energy Fuels Corp.](#) on construction of the station, and Alpine expects to have about a third of its 50-plus vehicle fleet converted to natural gas by the end of 2011. The company's transition to natural gas includes the use of new CNG-powered trucks as it phases out its older vehicles.
